Brief description of Programs

Be a Teacher or substitute teacher

This job doesn't provide monetary rewards but it does provide individuals opportunities to share their knowledge and experience to promote cultural values among VVM students. That satisfaction is far more rewarding and it promotes cultural values. Teachers should plan their curriculum in advance and get approved by VVM principal. Teach topics and generate VVM students' interest in respective subject.

VVM also seeks parent involvement as substitute teachers for classrooms. We also need parents who are willing to help support primary teacher for the subject. It is required that such helpers are always plugged in with primary teacher to ensure continuity.

Front desk and support staff

VVM needs volunteers for front desk to ensure that all students and parents are welcomed during the school sessions. They play key role in promoting VVM's image and in providing information ranging from registration to holiday schedules to Parents and students.

VVM also seeks volunteer that can support preparing class materials or simply support back office operations like entering registrations in database, maintaining newsletter publications, email lists etc

Event Management supporter
